- Supernatural conquest over Egypt. vs. 9-12
- Scriptural commands from Mount Sinai. vs. 13-18
- Satisfying covenant with Israel. vs. 19-25
- Steadfast compassion towards His people. vs. 26-38

APPLICATION ... Let's be honest with God

- 1) When we confess we are reminded of our personal corruption.

- 2) When we confess we are reminded of God's profound character.
