Revival Leads to Rededication
Nehemiah 10:1-39

Revival Is When ...

- 1) God's people become radically hungry for God's Word. (Nehemiah 8)
- 2) God's people become serious about their sin and humbly confess before God. (Nehemiah 9)

An Important Reminder About Revival ...

LESSON - Revival Leads to Rededication (Nehemiah 10:1-39)

- I. THE LIST THE PEOPLE vs. 1 27
- II. THE LESSONS THE PURPOSE vs. 28-39
 - 4 Things Are Rededicated
 - First, there is the rededication of their FEET to follow after God's Word. v. 29

"to walk in God's way ..."

- Second, there is the rededication of their <u>FAMILY</u> to Biblical separation and purity. v. 30 "we will not give our ..."
- > Third, there is the rededication of their **FAITH** to confidently trust in God. v. 31

"We will not buy from them ... we will forgo the crops the seventh year, and the exaction of every debt."

- Fourth, there is the rededication of their <u>FINANCES</u> to be used for God's purposes. vs. 32-39
 - v. 32 "to contribute yearly one third of a shekel ..."
 - v. 33 "... for all the work of the house of our God."
 - v. 34 "... so that they might bring it to the house of our God ..."
 - v. 35 "and that they might bring ... to the house of the Lord annually."
 - v. 36 "and bring to the house of our God ..."
 - v. 37 "we will also bring ... to the house of our God."
 - v. 38 "... shall bring up a tenth of the tithes to the house of our God."
 - v. 39 "For the sons of Israel and the sons of Levi shall bring their contribution ..."

Remember ...
