LESSON - 3 Stages of Motherhood

I. SARAH - THE PREPARATIONS FOR MOTHERHOOD

Her Story - Genesis 12;15;16;17;21

Her Statement - There are 2 $\underline{\text{LOVE}}$ relationships essential to prepare you for motherhood.

1) Your love for <u>GOD</u>. (See 16:1-6; 17:5-6; 21:1-3)

Note: Why chapters 18-20 and the story of Sodom and Gomorrah?

2) Your love for your <u>HUSBAND</u>. (12:10,14-20; 13:1; cf. 1 Peter 3:1-6)

II. HANNAH - THE PRACTICE OF MOTHERHOOD

Her Story - 1 Samuel 1:1-2:19

The obstacles she had to face

- 1) There was a moral **<u>DECLINE</u>** in the nation.
- 2) She faced unjust <u>CRITICISM</u> and <u>BLAME</u>.
- 3) There were ungodly **INFLUENCES**.

Her Statement - God may give you your heart's desire (child/children) so that you can give them **<u>BACK</u>** to Him again, and have more than you ever dreamed.

What it practically means to raise your children for the Lord

- 1) You must be a mother of **FAITH**.
- 2) Be careful not to be **OVERPROTECTIVE**.
- 3) TEACH your children at home.
- 4) Teach your child **<u>RESPONSIBILITY</u>**.
- 5) Never stop being **<u>INVOLVED</u>** in their life.

III. NAOMI - THE PANORAMA OF MOTHERHOOD

Her Story - Ruth 1-4

Her Statement - Your greatest sorrows in mothering may lead to God's greatest **BLESSINGS**.

2 Truths to glean from Naomi

- 1) Life is marked by **SORROWS**.
- 2) God never <u>ABANDONS</u> His own.
