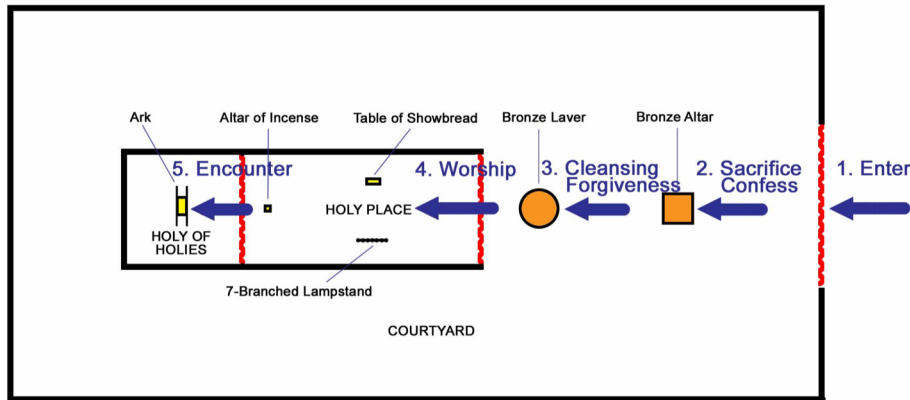
#### I. JESUS OUR "GREAT" HIGH PRIEST 4:14-16

*Who is He?*

His **PRIESTHOOD**. v. 14

- See 1:3; 2:17; 3:1

- Chapters 5-9 focus almost **EXCLUSIVELY** on Jesus' high priesthood.
- In 4:14 Jesus is called a **GREAT** high priest.



Jesus has "*passed through the heavens ...*" (Cf. 2 Corinthians 12:2-4)

So "*let us hold fast our confession.*"

#### Some application points ...

- 1) There is no need for a **JEWISH** or **RITUALISTIC** priesthood or sacrifice since Christ became our great high priest.
- 2) To not completely trust in Christ as our great high priest implies that the final and perfect atonement for sin has not been **MADE**, which is an **AFFRONT** to God.

His \_\_\_\_\_. v. 15

- We see Jesus' \_\_\_\_\_. "*... one who has been tempted in all things as we are ...*"
- We see Jesus' \_\_\_\_\_. "*... yet without sin.*"

His \_\_\_\_\_. v. 16

- There is a throne of \_\_\_\_\_. "*Therefore let us draw near with confidence to the throne of grace, ...*"
- There is a place of \_\_\_\_\_. "*so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.*"
