The Situation ... Why were they not growing?

LESSON - Let Us Press On to Maturity 6:1-3

I. THE APPEAL FOR MATURITY VS. 1-3

What is he telling them to do?

First — You must **SEPARATE** yourself from your current condition. vs. 1-2

The Terms ... "Therefore leaving the elementary teaching about the Christ, ... not laying again a foundation ..."

3 Foundational Doctrines of Judaism

- 1) "... of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God." v. 1
- 2) "... of instructions about washings and laying on of hands." v. 2
- 3) "... and the resurrection of the dead and eternal judgment." v. 2

The Teaching ...

- 1) For the Jewish person in that day.
- 2) For people today?

Second — You must <u>SUBMIT</u> yourself to God's sovereignty when it comes to growth. v. 3

"And this we will do, if God permits."

Today's Growth Points — The Implications of Sovereignty and Our Growth

- 1) God ultimately governs the progress of our sanctification (maturity).
- 2) God permitting us to advance to maturity is all of grace.
- 3) Nevertheless, it is to be our responsibility and joy to press on to maturity.
