The Perspective — How Should We Think of This Difficult Passage?

Hermeneutics for Difficult Passages

- 1) Always PRAY first.
- 2) Deal with SCRIPTURE alone.
- 3) Start with the <u>CLEAR</u> passages of Scripture.
- 4) Deal with the difficult passages in the LIGHT of the clear passages.
- 5) Realize that the author is not always writing to **INDIVIDUALS**, but rather Churches as a whole.
- 6) Check your conclusions with a trusted **COMMENTARY**.

The Passage — What Is It Teaching Us?

1) The **INVESTIGATION**. vs. 4-5 "For in the case of **those** ..."

Does it say they are "born-again"?

Does it say they had any spiritual experiences?

"once been enlightened"

"have tasted of the heavenly gift"

"made partakers of the Holy Ghost"

"have tasted the good word of God"

"and the **powers** of the age to come"

- 2) The <u>INDICTMENT</u>. v. 6 "and then have fallen away, it is impossible to renew them again to repentance, ..."
- 3) The **ILLUSTRATION**. vs. 7-8 "For **ground** that drinks the rain ..."
