The Perspective - How Should We Think of This Difficult Passage?

## Hermeneutics for Difficult Passages

1) Always PRAY first.
2) Deal with SCRIPTURE alone.
3) Start with the CLEAR passages of Scripture.
4) Deal with the difficult passages in the LIGHT of the clear passages.
5) Realize that the author is not always writing to INDIVIDUALS, but rather Churches as a whole.
6) Check your conclusions with a trusted COMMENTARY.

The Passage - What Is It Teaching Us?

1) The INVESTIGATION. vs. 4-5 "For in the case of those ..."

Does it say they are "born-again"?
Does it say they had any spiritual experiences?
"once been enlightened"
"have tasted of the heavenly gift"
"made partakers of the Holy Ghost"
"have tasted the good word of God"
"and the powers of the age to come"
2) The INDICTMENT. v. 6 "and then have fallen away, it is impossible to renew them again to repentance, ..."
3) The ILLUSTRATION. vs. 7-8 "For ground that drinks the rain ..."
