#### What we are going to learn today in our study ...

#### Hebrews 9:15-28

The theme of redemption, by blood, is pervasive in the Bible

- The death angel passed through Egypt and <u>SPARED</u> those who applied the blood (Exodus 11:4-6).
- The blood of Christ <u>SAVES</u> those who believe (Romans 3:25).

An inheritance, by the blood of Christ, through a last will and testament (Hebrews 9:15-28)

- Romans 8:16-17 "heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ"
- Ephesians 1:11-17 "We have obtained an inheritance"
- 1 Corinthians 3:22-23 "all things belong to you, and you belong to Christ; and Christ belongs to God."

A lesson from Genesis 15:9-18

Why the cutting of the animals?

Why didn't Abraham walk through the covenant pieces?

The Point of Hebrews 9:15-17 — In order for the New Covenant (Will or Testament) to be of any benefit to you, it was **NECESSARY** for Christ to die.

## II. THE PROMISES OF THE NEW COVENANT/WILL vs. 18-28

"Therefore ..."

We have total **FORGIVENESS** by Christ's blood. (vs. 18-26)

"blood" — 7x's (vs. 18,19,20,21,22,25)

"Christ has entered, ... heaven itself, now to **appear** in the presence of God **on our behalf**." v. 24

"... He has **appeared** once for all at the end of the ages **to put away sin** by the sacrifice of Himself." v. 26

## Today's Growth Point — How does this passage apply to you today?

1) To refuse Christ is to turn your back on the <u>ONE</u> place sin can be <u>FORGIVEN</u>.

2) God's love for His people has never **<u>BEGAN</u>** and will never <u>END</u>.
