THE PROMISES OF THE NEW COVENANT/WILL vs. 18-28

We have total **FORGIVENESS** by Christ's blood. (vs. 18-26)

We have complete **SALVATION** at the return of Christ. (vs. 27-28)

Note: What does it mean to be saved?

**Note:** There is only <u>ONE</u> salvation and one <u>WAY</u> of salvation.

#### 3 tenses of salvation in the New Testament

- 1) We <u>HAVE</u> been saved (past tense) from the <u>PENALTY</u> of sin = <u>JUSTIFICATION</u> *Ephesians 2:8-9*
- 2) We <u>ARE</u> being saved (present tense) from the <u>POWER</u> of sin = <u>SANCTIFICATION</u>

  1 Corinthians 1:18; 2 Corinthians 2:15
- 3) We <u>WILL</u> be saved (future tense) from the <u>PRESENCE</u> of sin = <u>GLORIFICATION</u>

  Romans 5:9

The Appointment For All Men (humanity) v. 27

"It is appointed for men to die once and after this comes the judgment."

The Appearance of Christ v. 28

"So Christ also, ... will appear a second time for salvation without reference to sin, to those who eagerly await Him."

See Philippians 3:20-21; 1 John 3:2

## Today's Growth Point — How does this passage apply to you today?

What is Jesus' Reason for Coming Back?

- 1) It is a **CONFIRMATION** that people only die once.
- 2) It <u>CONCLUDES</u> all opportunities for people to be saved.
- 3) It provides **CONFIDENCE** that all our sin has been fully dealt with.
- 4) It is for the **CONSUMMATION** of our salvation.
