The Examples of Faith (11)

The Features of Faith – Faith Described vs. 1-3

"The assurance of things hoped for ... "Is the ATTITUDE of faith.

"the conviction of things not seen ..." Is the ACTIONS of faith.

"for by it the men of old gained **approval** ..." Is the <u>APPROVAL</u> of faith.

"by faith we understand that the worlds ..." Is the ACCEPTANCE of faith.

The Family of Faith — Faith Displayed vs. 4-40

What we are going to learn today in our study ...

Hebrews 11:4

Abel: The **FIRST** man of faith.

Abel: The <u>WORSHIP</u> of faith. v. 4 - A picture of what it looks like when you first come to <u>SAVING</u> faith in Jesus Christ.

## LESSON - The Faith of Abel 11:4

I. THE STORY - Genesis 4:1-5

3 things are established in this story

- The **PLACE** of worship. "an offering to the Lord ..." vs. 3,4
- The **<u>TIME</u>** for worship. "*it came about in the course of time.*" v. 3
- The WAY to worship. "the Lord had regard .... He had no regard." vs. 4,5

The 2 responses in the story

- Abel is <u>OBEDIENT</u>.
- Cain is <u>DISOBEDIENT</u>.

## II. THE SIGNIFICANCE - Hebrews 11:4

"Abel offered to God a **better** sacrifice than Cain"

- Because it was a <u>BLOOD</u> offering.
- Because it was done in <u>OBEDIENCE</u>.
- Because it was by <u>FAITH</u>.

"Through which he obtained the **testimony** that he was righteous, God **testifying** about his gifts"

- Because he came on the only terms that God provides A <u>SACRIFICE</u> for sin.
- Because he proved he obtained righteousness by his <u>OBEDIENCE</u>.

Note the contrast with Cain who proved that he didn't obtain God's righteousness:

- 1. He became ANGRY. (Genesis 4:5-6)
- 2. He rejected God's <u>GRACE</u>. (Genesis 4:7)
- 3. He MURDERED. (Genesis 4:8)
- 4. He <u>AVOIDED</u> the Lord. (Genesis 4:9)
- 5. He failed to **<u>REPENT</u>**. (Genesis 4:10-15)
- 6. He walked <u>AWAY</u> from God. (Genesis 4:16)

## "and through faith, though he is dead, still speaks"

- You must come by FAITH, not WORKS.
- This is based on the <u>REVELATION</u> of God, not the <u>REASONING</u> of man.
- To neglect God's <u>ONLY</u> way is to invite God's <u>JUDGMENT</u>.
