The Features of Faith — Faith Described vs. 1-3

The Family of Faith — Faith Displayed vs. 4-40

Abel: The <u>WORSHIP</u> of faith. v. 4 — A picture of what it looks like when you first come to <u>SAVING</u> faith in Jesus Christ. "Abel offered to God a better sacrifice ..."

Enoch: The <u>WALK</u> of faith. vs. 5-6 — A picture of what it looks like when you truly are <u>SEEKING</u> God by faith. "Enoch walked with God ..." (cf. Genesis 5:22,24)

Noah: The <u>WORK</u> of faith. v. 7 — A picture of what it looks like when you truly <u>SERVE</u> God by faith. "Noah **prepared** an ark ..." (cf. Genesis 6:8-22)

Abraham: The <u>WORTHY</u> example of faith. vs. 8-19 - A picture of what it looks like when you truly <u>SURRENDER</u> to God by faith.

## V. ABRAHAM'S PROOF OF FAITH vs. 17-19

The Process — How Faith Develops

You begin your **PILGRIMAGE**. (v.8)

You continue to live **PATIENTLY** waiting for the promise of the eternal state. (vs. 9-10)

As you wait, your confidence begins to proclaim God's **POWER** to do anything. (vs. 11-12)

And you become more **PERSUADED** of God's promises. (vs. 13-16)

And God uses the tests in your life to **PROVE** the reality of your faith. (vs. 17-19)

The Picture

The Offering vs. 17-18 "By faith Abraham .... offered up Isaac ... his only begotten son."

It places Abraham in a <u>PERPLEXITY</u> unlike anyone else in Hebrews 11 - Cf. Genesis 17:15-21 with Genesis 22:2

It places Abraham in a **PAINFUL** situation.

- It is the loss of his own <u>CHILD</u>. "...your only son, whom you love..." (Genesis 22:2)
- 2) It is the loss of his **UNIQUE** son. "... only begotten son." (Hebrews 11:17)
- It is the death of his own son by his own <u>HANDS</u>. "Abraham offered up Isaac" (Hebrews 11:17; cf. Genesis 9:6)

The Obvious v. 19 "He considered that God is able to raise people even from the dead, from which he also received him back as a type." (Cf. Genesis 22:5 "I and the boy will go over there and worship and come again to you.")

The Application — Faith is sometimes called to not WITHHOLD your dearest from God.
