Abel: The <u>WORSHIP</u> of faith. v. 4 - A picture of what it looks like when you first come to <u>SAVING</u> faith in Jesus Christ. "Abel offered to God a better sacrifice ..."

Enoch: The <u>WALK</u> of faith. vs. 5-6 - A picture of what it looks like when you truly are <u>SEEKING</u> God by faith. "*Enoch walked with God ..."* (cf. Genesis 5:22,24)

Noah: The <u>WORK</u> of faith. v. 7 — A picture of what it looks like when you truly <u>SERVE</u> God by faith. "Noah **prepared** an ark ..." (cf. Genesis 6:8-22)

Abraham: The <u>WORTHY</u> example of faith. vs. 8-19-A picture of what it looks like when you truly <u>SURRENDER</u> to God by faith.

Isaac, Jacob, and Joseph: The  $\underline{WAY}$  of faith passed on. vs. 20-22 — A picture of what it looks like when you SUCCESSFULLY communicate your faith to your children.

Moses: The <u>WEALTH</u> of faith pursued. vs. 23-28 - A picture of what it looks like when you **SEIZE** eternal treasures by faith.

The Israelites - The <u>WITNESSES</u> of courageous faith. vs. 29-40 - A picture of what it looks like when your life makes a **STATEMENT** of confident faith.

"And others" — 3 groups under the shadows of persecution

The First Group — Those who are being ABUSED. vs. 35b-36

"tortured"

"mocking"

"scourgings"

"chains and imprisonment"

The Second Group — Those who are being MARTYRED. v. 37a

"stoned"

"sawn in two"

"tempted/tested"

"put to death with the sword"

The Third Group — Those who are being ABANDONED. vs. 37b-38

"went about in sheepskins, in goatskins"

"being destitute, afflicted, ill-treated"

"wandering in deserts and mountains and caves and holes in the ground.
