Noah: The WORK of faith. v. 7 - A picture of what it looks like when you truly SERVE God by faith. "Noah prepared an ark ..." (cf. Genesis 6:8-22)

Abraham: The WORTHY example of faith. vs. 8-19 - A picture of what it looks like when you truly SURRENDER to God by faith.

Isaac, Jacob, and Joseph: The WAY of faith passed on. vs. 20-22 - A picture of what it looks like when you SUCCESSFULLY communicate your faith to your children.

Moses: The WEALTH of faith pursued. vs. 23-28 - A picture of what it looks like when you SEIZE eternal treasures by faith.

The Israelites - The WITNESSES of courageous faith. vs. 29-40 - A picture of what it looks like when your life makes a STATEMENT of confident faith.

The transition from INDIVIDUALS (vs. 4-28) to ISRAELITES - "they" vs. 29-40

Joshua and the Israelites v. 30 (cf. Joshua 6:1-20)
The Obstacles - What they faced
A FORTRESS "the walls of Jericho" (v. 30)
Their FEARS "... we have seen the giants, and we were in our own sight like grasshoppers." (Numbers 13:33)

The Order - What God said to do
"... after they had been encircled for seven days." (cf. Joshua 6:3)
The Obedience - What they did
"By faith ..."

Rahab and the Israelites v. 31 (Cf. Joshua 2, 6)
The Setting - The town of Jericho
A $\qquad$ city.

A $\qquad$ city. (The 2 spies Joshua \& Caleb - Cf. Joshua 2:1-7)
"... Rahab the harlot did not perish along with those who were disobedient (them that believed not-K.J.)"

The Separation - What Rahab did (She Believed - cf. Joshua 2:8-13)
"By faith Rahab the harlot did not perish ... after she had welcomed the spies in peace."

Other Israelites vs. 32-35a
"And what more shall I say? For time will fail me if I tell of ..."
Gideon demonstrated a faith in God's plan that $\qquad$ physical limitations.

Barak demonstrated a faith that $\qquad$ his personal pride.

Samson demonstrated a faith that $\qquad$ his past failures.
