Hebrews 12:12-17

The Connection with vs. 1-11 — "Therefore"

Christians live on two sides of the same coin: <u>DOCTRINES</u> (what we believe) & **EXHORTATIONS** (what we do). 1 Timothy 6:2; 2 Timothy 4:1-2

Because the Christian life is a  $\frac{\text{COMMUNITY}}{\text{project}}$  project we need each other (see the language used in vs. 12-17)

The Caution — This is the 5<sup>th</sup> warning in Hebrews

- 1. Drifting from the Word (2:1-4)
- 2. Doubting the Word (3:7-4:13)
- 3. Dull toward the Word (5:11-6:20)
- 4. Despising the Word (10:26-39)
- 5. Disobeying the Word (12:14-19)

LESSON - The Christian Life: 3 Things We All Need 12:12-17

I. TO BE PREPARED FOR THE BATTLE — Encourage One Another vs. 12-13

The Problem — "... hands that are **weak** and the knees that are **feeble**."

The Practice — "Strengthen the hands .... make straight paths for your feet, so that ..."

The Application Point — How would you encourage others through Isaiah 53:1-4?

II. TO BE AT <u>PEACE</u> & <u>PURSUE</u> SANCTIFICATION (HOLINESS) — Help Each Other v. 14

The Passage — What it does and does not say.

The Perspective — The root (justification) and fruit (sanctification) of salvation.

"Pursue **peace** with all men" — This is loving **OTHERS**. (Romans 12:18; James 3:13-18)

"and the sanctification without which no one will see the Lord" — This is loving  $\underline{GOD}$ . (1 John 3:2-3)

The Application Point — What effort have you put into helping one another reconcile relationships and live godlier?

III. TO BE PROTECTING ONE ANOTHER — Watch Out For Each Other vs. 15-17

The Call — "See to it ..." (GK. Episkopeō)

The Challenge — 2 Things to make sure of:

"that no one comes short of the grace of God." — That is about God's HELP.

"that **no root of bitterness springing up** causes trouble, and by it many be defiled."— This is about their **HARDNESS** 

The Case — "that there be **no immoral or godless person like Esau**, who sold his own birthright for a single meal.

The Application Point — Have you accepted your responsibility to warn and watch out for each other?
