Verses 1-17 are **EXHORTATIONS** to live the Christian life.

Verses 18-24 are about our **MOTIVATIONS** to live the Christian life.

Chapters 1-10 — The **<u>REPEATED</u>** contrast of the Covenants (under Jesus)

Chapter 12:18-24 — The **<u>REPRESENTATION</u>** of the Covenants contrasted (2 mountains)

I. THE EXPERIENCE OF THE OLD COVENANT - Mount Sinai vs. 18-21

"For you have not come to a mountain ..."

The Picture — Exodus 19 & 20

The **<u>REVELATION</u>** from God (Exodus 19:16-19; Deuteronomy 4:11-14)

The **<u>RESPONSE</u>** from the people (Exodus 20:18-21; Deuteronomy 5:23-27)

The Point — Come near but keep your **DISTANCE**.

The Application Point — To be a Christian, means we must first hear the <u>RUMBLINGS</u> of the law before we can experience the <u>RESCUE</u> of grace.

II. THE EXPERIENCE OF THE NEW COVENANT - Mount Zion vs. 22-24

"But you have come to Mount Zion ..."

The Message – Come <u>NEAR</u> and draw close!

The Motivation — 7 Things

#1 — "But you have come to **Mount Zion**, and to the **city of the living God**, the **heavenly Jerusalem**, "v. 22a

- #2 "... and to myriads of angels (ESV "in festal gathering)" v. 22b
- #3 "to the general assembly and church of the firstborn who are enrolled in heaven, ..." v. 23a
- #4 "... and to God, the Judge of all, ..." v. 23b
- #5 "... and to the spirits of the righteous made perfect." v. 23c
- #6 "and to Jesus, the mediator of a new covenant, ..." v. 24a
- #7 "... and to the sprinkled blood, which speaks better than the blood of Abel." v. 24b

The Application Point — To be a Christian means we <u>CELEBRATE</u> when we come to worship God!
