#### LESSON - A Summary of the Christian Life 13:15-25

I. YOU SEE IT IN OUR <u>SACRIFICAL</u> LIFE. vs. 15-16

The Contrast of Worship — The O.T. & N.T. Sacrifices

"Through Him then, let us continually offer up a sacrifice of praise to God, ..."

The Concept of Worship — The Necessary Elements

Content of Worship — We offer sacrifice with our:

- LIPS v. 15 "... the fruit of lips that give thanks to His name."
- LIVES v. 16 "And do not neglect doing good and sharing, for with such sacrifices God is pleased."

II. YOU SEE IT IN OUR SUBMISSION & SUPPLICATIONS FOR LEADERSHIP. vs. 17-19

The Problem — Why do some resist obeying and submitting to leaders?

- The previous <u>EXPERIENCES</u> with leaders in Churches.
- The prevalent **EXHORTATIONS** in Scripture.

The Picture — Why are you to obey and submit to your leaders? v. 17

- They are <u>RESPONSIBLE</u> to God. "... for they keep watch over your souls ... give an account."
- You will **<u>REGRET</u>** it "... for this would be unprofitable for you."

The Practice — 2 things you are to do:

- Offer <u>SUBMISSION</u> "obey your leaders and submit to them." v. 17
- Offer <u>SUPPLICATIONS</u> "Pray for us, ..." vs. 18-19

#### III. YOU SEE IT IN OUR STRENGTH FROM GOD. vs. 20-21

The Principle — What God commands He provides

The Person — Who is this God that enables us?

- A <u>PEACE</u> giving God. "Now the God of peace, ..."
- A LIFE giving God. "... who brought up from the dead ..."
- A SHEPHERDING God. "... the great Shepherd of the sheep ..."
- A <u>COVENANT</u> keeping God. "through the blood of the eternal covenant, ..."
- An **EQUIPPING** God. "equip you in every good thing to do His will, working in us ..."
- A Christ **EXALTING** God. "... to whom be the glory forever and ever. Amen."
