1 John 2:15-17 01/20/19

REVIEW — Let's remember what we learned in our study of 1 John 2...

John's Afflictions to the Comfortable (Exhortations) — vs. 1-11

Test # 1 - Do you confess Christ and your sin, and do you have a spirit of loving obedience to Christ?

Test # 2 - Do you love others *like* Christ has loved you?

John's Comfort to the Afflicted (Encouragements) — vs. 12-14

"Little children/children" — The encouragement of **SINS** forgiven. (vs. 12, 13c)

"Fathers" — The encouragement of **SOVEREIGNTY** forever. (v. 13a, 14a)

"Young men" — The encouragement of **STRONG** faith. (vs. 13b, 14b)

INTRODUCTION — John's Prohibition (v. 15) and Promise (v. 17)

The Command — "Do not love the world nor the things in the world."

The Concept — The World ... Greek "kosmos" (used 186 times in the N.T.)

- The world as a **PLACE**. (Matthew 13:35; Acts 17:24; 1 Timothy 6:7)
- The world as a **PEOPLE**. (John 1:10; 3:16)
- The world as a <u>PHILOSOPHY</u>. (John 15:18-19; Ephesians 6:11-12; James 4:4; 1 John 4:4-6, 5:4-5,19)

I. LOVE FOR THE WORLD REVEALS OUR TRUE DISPOSITION. v. 15

"if anyone **loves** the world, the **love** of the Father is not in him."

The Question — What does your **LOVE** reveal about you?

II. LOVE FOR THE WORLD REFLECTS OUR TEMPORAL DELUSION. v. 16

"For all that is **in** the world ... **is not** from the Father, **but is** from the world."

"The **lust** of the **flesh**" — This is the **CRAVINGS** for sin = Self-**PLEASING**

"and the **lust** of the **eyes**" — This is the **CONNECTION** to sin = Self-**PURSUITS**

"and the **boastful pride** of life" — This is the **CONCLUSION** of sin = Self-**PROMOTIONS**

The Question — What do your **LONGINGS** reveal about you?

III. LOVE FOR THE WORLD RESULTS IN OUR TRAGIC DESTRUCTION. v. 17

"The world is passing away, and also its lusts; ..."

"... but the one who does the will of God lives forever."

The Question — What does your <u>LIFESTYLE</u> reveal about you?

Apply it - So what should we do with what we've heard today?
