REVIEW — Evidences of fellowship with God and one another

The **DOCTRINAL** test — "if we **say** ..." (what we believe)

Test #1 — Do you *confess* Christ and your sin?

The ${\color{red} {\bf OBEDIENCE}}$ test - "if we walk in the light ..." (how we live)

Test #2 — Do you have a spirit of *loving* obedience to Christ?

The $\underline{\textbf{RELATIONAL}}$ test - "If we love one another ..." (how we relate to one another)

Test #3 — Do you love others like Christ has loved you?

- I. 1st YOU MUST HAVE A CATEGORY FOR FALSE TEACHING v. 1
- II. 2nd YOU MUST HAVE <u>CLARITY</u> ABOUT THE PERSON OF JESUS CHRIST vs. 2-3

4 main errors/false teachings about Christ

- Arianism Jesus was not fully <u>GOD</u>. It denied his <u>DEITY</u>.
- Docetism Jesus only appeared to be **HUMAN**. It denied his **HUMANITY**.
- Nestorianism The human and the divine were not <u>UNITED</u>. It denied Jesus was <u>ONE</u> person, but taught He was two different people in one body.
- Eutychianism The divine and human are all <u>MIXED</u> up. It denied Jesus was one person with <u>TWO</u> distinct natures and taught He was not fully human or divine.
- III. 3rd YOU MUST HAVE A <u>CONFIDENCE</u> IN THE SPIRIT OF GOD v. 4
- IV. 4th YOU MUST HAVE A <u>CAUTION</u> ABOUT WHO YOU LISTEN TO v. 5
- V. 5th YOU MUST HAVE A <u>COMMITMENT</u> TO APOSTOLIC (BIBLICAL) TEACHING v. 6
