LESSON - What Is the Goal of Your Life? (3:12-16)

I. THE PURPOSE FOR PURSUING THE PRIZE

Why should I pursue Christ as the goal of my life?

- It <u>GLORIFIES</u> God.
- It <u>CONFIRMS</u> salvation.
- It is a good **<u>TESTIMONY</u>**.
- It provides **<u>ASSURANCE</u>**.
- It spares unnecessary <u>SORROW</u>.
- It protects the cause of Christ from **<u>REPROACH</u>**.

II. THE PROOF OF PURSUING THE PRIZE vs. 12-16

How would I know if I am pursuing Christ as the goal of my life?

• There is a holy **DISSATISFACTION** within you. (v. 12a)

"Not that I have already **obtained** it or have already become **perfect** ..."

• There is a holy **<u>DETERMINATION</u>** about you. (v. 12b)

" but I **press on** also that I **may lay hold of that** for which also I was laid hold of by Christ Jesus."

• There is a holy **<u>DISCIPLINE</u>** that defines you. (v. 13)

"Brethren, I do not regard myself as having laid hold of it yet; **but one thing I** do: forgetting what lies behind and **reaching forward** to what lies ahead,"

• There is a holy **DESIRE** that burns in you. (vs. 14-15)

"I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus. Let us therefore, as **many as are perfect**, have this **attitude**; and if in anything you have a different attitude, **God will reveal** that also to you;"

• There is a holy **<u>DEDICATION</u>** in your walk. (v. 16)

"however, let us **keep living by that same standard** to which we have attained."
