 1. It begins the **4TH** book of the Psalms.
 2. It is the **OLDEST** and **ONLY** Psalm by Moses.
 3. It is a **PRAYER**.

LESSON — A NEW YEAR'S PRAYER (Psalm 90)

I. THE PASSAGE — 4 Affirmations to Remember

Affirmation #1 — God is **ETERNAL**. vs. 1-2

The response — This is **GLORIOUS!**

Affirmation #2 — We are **MORTAL**. vs. 3-6

The response — This is **TROUBLING!**

Affirmation #3 — God is **ANGRY** at us because of our sin. vs. 7-11

The response — This is **DEVASTATING!**

Affirmation #4 — God is **FAITHFUL** to His promises to His covenant people. vs. 13-17

The response — This is **INCREDIBLE!**

II. THE PRAYER — 1 Prayer to Reflect

“So teach us to number our days, that we may present to You a heart of wisdom.” — v. 12

What He Prays — *“So teach us to number our days, ...”*

Why He Prays — *“ ... that we may present to You a heart of wisdom.”*

This wisdom is the result of becoming a new **PERSON**. (2 Timothy 3:14-15)

This wisdom leads to a new **PERSPECTIVE**. (Proverbs 1:7)

This wisdom changes your **PURPOSE**. (Proverbs 11:30; cf. 1 Corinthians 1:18-31, 2:1-5)
