- A. Note Mark's **ARRANGEMENT** of the stories
- B. Note the actual Greek Word, meaning LITTLE DOG

- C. Note that this distinction between "little dog" and "children" was a traditional distinction between **JEW** and **GENTILE**
- D. In this parable, Jesus is not calling this woman inferior, belittling this woman, or saying that the kingdom is not for Gentiles. Rather, He's making clear that His calling is <u>FIRST</u> to the Jews

• Jesus is the Savior of both **JEWS** and **GENTILES**

- We should model the same **<u>FAITH</u>** as this woman
- We should remember that the Gospel is good news for **<u>EVERYONE</u>**
