### I. THE STORY — What Happened?

The Place v. 1

*“In those days, when there was again a large crowd and they had **nothing to eat**, ...”*

**Key Point** — This is a \_\_\_\_\_ crowd.

The Problem vs. 2-4

***“I feel compassion for the people because they have **remained with Me now three days** and have nothing to eat... And His disciples answered Him, **‘Where will anyone be able to find enough bread here in this desolate place to satisfy these people?’”*****

**Key Point** — Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ compassion.

The Provision vs. 5-8

*“And He was asking them, ‘How many loaves **do you have?’** ... and taking the seven loaves, He gave thanks and broke them and started giving them **to His disciples** to serve to **them**, and they **served them** to the people. They also had a few small fish; ... He ordered these **to be served as well**. “And they ate and **were satisfied**; and they picked up **seven large baskets** full of what was left over of the broken pieces.”*

The Parting vs. 9-10

*“And about **four thousand were there**, and **He sent them away**. And **immediately He entered the boat** with His disciples and came to the district of Dalmanutha.”*
