I. THE STORY – What Happened?

The Place v. 1

"In those days, when there was again a large crowd and they had nothing to eat, ..."

Key Point — This is a _____ crowd.

"I feel compassion for the people because they have remained with Me now three days and have nothing to eat... And His disciples answered Him, 'Where will anyone be able to find enough bread here in this desolate place to satisfy these people?"

Key Point – Jesus _____ compassion.

The Provision vs. 5-8

"And He was asking them, 'How many loaves **do you have**?' and taking the seven loaves, He gave thanks and broke them and started giving them **to His disciples** to serve to **them**, and they **served them** to the people. They also had a few small fish; ... He ordered these **to be served as well**. "And they ate and **were satisfied**; and they picked up **seven large baskets** full of what was left over of the broken pieces."

The Parting vs. 9-10

"And about **four thousand were there**, and **He sent them away**. And **immediately He entered the boat** with His disciples and came to the district of Dalmanutha."
