## II. THE MESSIAH'S CORONATION — Things Mark Wants Us to See (vs. 1-11)

The Path (v. 1a)

*“As they **approached** Jerusalem, at Bethphage and **Bethany** “*

The Plan (vs. 1b-7; cf. Matthew 21:4-5)

*“He **sent** two of His disciples, and said to them; “Go ... **you will find** ... If anyone says to you ... **you say** ... They spoke to them **just as Jesus had told them**, ... “*

The Praise (vs. 8-10)

*“Many spread their coats ... and others spread leafy branches ... Those who were in **front** and those who **followed** were shouting Hosanna!*

The Problem (v. 11)

*“Jesus entered Jerusalem and **came into the temple**; and after **looking around** at everything, He **left** ...”*

**The Application Point** — He is grieved, burdened, and filled with righteous anger because the temple failed to \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ to who He truly was! (Cf. Malachi 3:1-2)
