

The Path (v. 1a)

"As they **approached** Jerusalem, at Bethphage and **Bethany**"

The Plan (vs. 1b-7; cf. Matthew 21:4-5)

"He <u>sent</u> two of His disciples, and said to them; "Go ... <u>you will</u> <u>find</u> ... If anyone says to you ... <u>you say</u> ... They spoke to them <u>just as Jesus had told them</u>, ... "

The Praise (vs. 8-10)

"Many spread their coats ... and others spread leafy branches ... Those who were in **front** and those who **followed** were shouting Hosanna!

The Problem (v. 11)

"Jesus entered Jerusalem and <u>came into the temple</u>; and after l<u>ooking around</u> at everything, He <u>left</u> ..."
