The Connection – “On the **first day of Unleavened Bread**, when the **Passover** lamb was **being sacrificed**, ...” (14:12)

Mark 14 is a chapter of _____ for the Cross (vs. 12,15,16)

Note ... Up to this point the preparations (though divinely orchestrated) have been done by _____ people, but now _____ Himself is the one doing the preparations and it centers around the Passover (vs. 12-25)

Lesson – A Passover *With* the Lamb

I. **THE SCENE** – **The Passover and Unleavened Bread** (vs. 12-21)

The Preparations (vs. 12-16)

*“His disciples said to Him, where do You want us to go and **prepare** for You to eat the Passover”*

The Prophecy (vs. 17-20)

*“truly I say to you that one of you will **betray** me — the one who is eating **with Me.**”*

The Plan (v. 21)

*“For the Son of Man is to go just **as it is written** of Him; but **woe to that man by whom** the Son of Man is betrayed! It would have been **good for that man if he had not been born.**”*

II. THE SUPPER — The New Covenant (vs. 22-26)

*“While they were **eating**, He **took some bread** ... and when He had **taken a cup** ... ”*

The Elements (vs. 22-24)

The Bread — Its Purpose (v. 22)

*“This do in **remembrance**”* (cf. Luke 22:19; I Corinthians 11:25)

The Cup — Its Purpose (vs. 23-24)

*“This is My **blood of the covenant**, which is poured out for many.”*
(cf. Exodus 24:7-8; Jeremiah 31:31-34; Hebrews 9:12-10:4)

The Expectation (v. 25; Cf. Luke 22:15-16)

*“Truly I say to you, I will never again drink of the fruit of the **vine until that day** when I drink it new in the kingdom of God.”*
