I. Two Clear Scriptural Truths

- We are Saved by **GRACE**

(Rom 3:28; 4:5; 5:1, 9-11; 1 Tim 1:15-16; 2 Tim 1:9; Titus 3:5; Eph 2:8-9)

- We are Judged by **WORKS**

(Matthew 7:21; 12:33-37; John 5:28-29; Gal 6:8-9; Rom 14:19-12; 2 Tim 4:14; 2 Cor 11:15; James 2:24)

II. The Examination of Works in the Final Judgment

- The Works of the **REDEEMED** (v.7, 10)

Justification by faith alone does not negate the works of righteousness in the believer's life. Scripture makes clear that just as surely as we are saved by our faith we will be judged by our works. When in sovereign grace God receives a sinner at the time of his conversion, He asks nothing but that he believe in Jesus Christ and submit to Him. But from that moment on, the believer enters into a responsibly of obedience, and the mark of his new spiritual life becomes his obedience to God. Faith in Christ does not produce freedom to sin and to do as we please but freedom from sin and a new, God-given desire and capacity to do what pleases him – John MacArthur
