## I. God's Word Is <u>AUTHORITATIVE</u>

- A. All the words in Scripture are God's words in such a way that to disbelieve or disobey any word of **SCRIPTURE** is to disbelieve or disobey **GOD**
- B. God's Word is authoritative over us to the same degree that **GOD HIMSELF** is authoritative over us.
- C. **JESUS** believed that the Old Testament was inspired by God
  - 1. Jesus attributed the Old Testament writing to the **HOLY SPIRIT** (Mark 12:35-37)

	2. Jesus referred to the Old Testament books as <b>SCRIPTURE</b> from God ( <i>Luke 4</i> )
	3. Jesus used <u>SCRIPTURE</u> and <u>GOD</u> interchangeably (Matthew 19)
D.	The New Testament <b>APOSTLES</b> believed the Old Testament was inspired by God
Е.	Jesus and the Apostles believed their <b>OWN</b> teachings and writings were inspired and authoritative (John 12:48-50; Eph 2:2-3, 3:4-5; Acts 10; Gal 1:11-12)
God's Word is <u>POWERFUL</u>	
Α.	The Word of God <u>AWAKENS</u> faith (1 Peter 1:23; James 1:18; Rom 10:14-17)
В.	The Word of God frees from <b>SIN</b> (John 8:32; Rom 6:17; Ps 119:9)
C.	The Word of God is our tool for <b>SPIRITUAL WARFARE</b> (Eph 6:11, 19; 1 John 2:14)
D.	The Word of God <b>SANCTIFIES</b> and empowers <b>GODLINESS</b> (John 17:17; 2 Peter 1:3-4)
E.	The Word of God gives <b>JOY</b> (John 15:11; Jeremiah 15:16; Psalm 119:2, 14, 127, 50)
F.	The Word of God gives <b>GUIDANCE</b> and <b>WISDOM</b> (Proverbs 3:5-6)
G.	The Word of God reveals <u>CHRIST</u>
