I. God's Word Is Sufficient

A. What is the sufficiency of Scripture? *The sufficiency of Scripture means that all things necessary for **SALVATION** and for living the Christian life in **OBEDIENCE** to God and for his **GLORY** are given to us in the Scriptures*

C. Why is the sufficiency of Scripture so important?

1. The sufficiency of Scripture allows us to keep **TRADITION** in its place
2. The sufficiency of Scriptures keeps us from **ADDING** to or **SUBTRACTING** from God's Word
3. The sufficiency of Scripture ensures the Word of God to be **RELEVANT** To all of life
4. The sufficiency of Scripture invites us to open our **BIBLES** to hear the voice of God to guide our lives

 - For our **COUNSELING**
 - For our **CHURCH GROWTH**
 - For our **CORPORATE WORSHIP**
 - For our **PERSONAL SPIRITUAL GROWTH**
