I. <u>12 Principles about How to Disagree with other Christians over Matters of Conscience</u>

1. **WELCOME** those who disagree with you (v.1-2)

2. Those with a free conscience must not **LOOK DOWN** on those without a free conscience (v.3-4)

3.	Those without a free conscience must not be JUDGMENTAL toward those with a free conscience (v.3-4)
	• You are not GOD
	• You are not others' MASTER
4.	Each believer must be fully CONVINCED of their position in their own conscience (v.5)
5.	Assume the BEST of your brothers and sisters in Christ (v.6-9)
6.	Remember that God alone is the $\underline{\textbf{JUDGE}}$, and we will all one day stand before His judgment (v.10-12)
7.	Though your freedom of conscience might be correct, don't let your freedom DESTROY the faith of a weak brother (v.13-15)
