

How To Disagree on Matters of Conscience (Part 3) Romans 14:16 - 15:13

I. <u>13 Principles about How to Disagree with other Christians over Matters of Conscience</u>

- 1. **WELCOME** those who disagree with you (14:1-2)
- 2. Those with a free conscience must not **LOOK DOWN** on those without a free conscience (14:3-4)
- 3. Those without a free conscience must not be **JUDGMENTAL** toward those with a free conscience (14:3-4)
- 4. Each believer must be fully **CONVINCED** of their position in their own conscience (14:5)
- 5. Assume the **BEST** of your brothers and sisters in Christ (14:6-9)
- 6. Remember that God alone is the **JUDGE**, and we will all one day stand before His judgment (14:10-12)
- 7. Though your freedom of conscience might be correct, don't let your freedom **DESTROY** the faith of a weak brother (14:13-15)

8.	Remember what is important in the KINGDOM OF GOD (14:16-21)
9.	If you have freedom, don't FLAUNT it; If you are strict, don't BIND others (14:22a)
10	.A person who lives according to their conscience is BLESSED (14:22b-23)
11	.We must follow the example of JESUS , who put others first (15:1-6)
12	.We bring glory to God when we WELCOME one another as Christ as welcomed us (15:7)
13	.We must remember that Jesus came and died to ${\color{red} {\bf UNITE}}$ us together — Jews and Gentiles alike — as one in Him (15:8-13)
